Guy Fawkes Night, also known as **Guy Fawkes Day**, **Bonfire Night** and **Firework Night**, is an annual commemoration observed on 5 November, primarily in Great Britain. Its history begins with the events of 5 November 1605, when <u>Guy Fawkes</u>, a member of the <u>Gunpowder Plot</u>, was arrested while guarding <u>explosives</u> the plotters had placed beneath the <u>House of Lords</u>. Celebrating the fact that <u>King James I</u> had survived the attempt on his life, people lit <u>bonfires</u> around London; and months later, the introduction of the <u>Observance of 5th November Act</u> enforced an annual public day of thanksgiving for the plot's failure.
